IMPORTANT: Changes in course offer

Rotterdam Business School was forced to withdraw their International Business year 3 programmes (both the specialisation Commerce and Marketing) from their course offer. This means that as of this academic year they only offer senior Business exchange programmes (4th year), except for Business & Society and Working World Wide. These two programmes also accept students who only completed 2 years out of a 4-year bachelor's degree or 1 year out of a 3-year bachelor's degree.

*Admission requirements

Each exchange programme has its own specific admission requirements. You can find these on the exchange programme page under the header *"practical matters –admission requirements"* or you can click on the link in the second column (see next page).

Also, please be aware that we can't always guarantee that students will be accepted to their 1st programme preference (e.g. due maximum capacity programmes or not meeting the requirements based on study background). Therefore we will ask your students to indicate their programme preferences in the online application form: 1st, 2nd and 3rd preference. If we have to ask students to transfer to another (similar) programme, we will contact you and the student(s) as soon as possible during or shortly after the application period. Students, and partners, will be informed about the student's acceptance mid-May.

Digital Learning Agreement (for Erasmus+ partners and students only)

Last year we started working with Digital Learning Agreements. We kindly ask you <u>not to</u> sign and send any Digital Learning Agreements before your student has received an official Letter of Acceptance from us, as we can never guarantee that students will get accepted to their 1st choice. In the Letter of Acceptance we will also mention the contact details to whom the digital Learning Agreement can be sent (this varies per exchange programme). We will not accept or process any Digital Learning Agreements before mid-May.
