Rotterdam University Of Applied Sciences – Applications For Spring 2026 Exchange Programmes

Rotterdam University of Applied Sciences – 2026 Spring Nominations Have Started, The related announcement is as follows;

Rotterdam University of Applied Sciences has officially opened the nomination and application process for the Spring 2026 exchange programmes. Applications will be managed through the university's online system, **Mobility Online**.

Important Deadlines

- Nomination by Partner Universities: until 15 October 2025
- Online Application by Students: 1 25 October 2025

Students whose nominations have been confirmed by partner universities will be able to submit their applications via Mobility Online. All applications must be completed by **25 October 2025**. After this date, the system will close, and no further applications will be accepted. Please note that Willem de Kooning Academy follows a separate nomination and application procedure.

Programmes and Admission Requirements

A detailed overview of the exchange programmes offered for the Spring 2026 semester has been provided by the university. Programme selection should be made in close consultation with nominated students, taking into account their academic background, the specific admission requirements, and the existing partnership agreements. For nominations outside the agreed scope, prior approval via email is required before submitting the nomination in Mobility Online.

Student Housing

The university, in cooperation with SSH, will make approximately 100 furnished student rooms available for incoming exchange students. Registration for SSH housing will open on 19 November 2025, followed by the booking process on 26 November 2025. As availability is limited, early registration is strongly recommended. Additionally, a housing information webinar will be held on 5 November 2025.

Due to the growing housing shortage in Rotterdam and the Netherlands in general, students who wish or need to secure private accommodation are strongly advised to start their search immediately after receiving their official letter of acceptance (mid/end of November). Students should also be cautious of potential fraudulent activities on the private housing market.

Visa and Residence Permit

Students from non-EU/EEA countries and Switzerland who plan to attend an exchange programme at Rotterdam UAS for more than three months are required to obtain a residence permit. Students must provide proof of sufficient funds to cover living expenses in the

Netherlands (€1,095 per month). This proof can be provided either through a bank transfer to the university's account (most common method) or through a scholarship award letter.

Following acceptance into one of the exchange programmes (mid-November), the **Student Support Team** will provide detailed information regarding the application process and the required documents. All documents must be submitted by **1 December 2025**.
