PROGRAM QUALIFICATIONS

1. Explains the nature, needs and performance of the person in relation to daily life, production, leisure activities and duties, and the relationship between activity and health and well-being.
2. Analyzes the knowledge of biological, medical, human, psychological, social, technological and occupational sciences, synthesizes these information together with theories related to activity and participation, and determines the possibilities and restricted aspects of the person.
3. Prevents by critically interpreting activity and participation constraints and by choosing one of the professional roles (treatment, counseling, etc.), works person-centered using rehabilitation and treatment activities.
4. Selects appropriate theories and models to fulfill the activity and vital roles of people and communities and to determine their health needs and plans intervention by analyzing and synthesizing.
5. Practices occupational therapy intervention by working closely with people and communities; works to improve social participation by creating accessible, adaptable environments.
6. Works in cooperation and interdisciplinary with service providers, caregivers, team members and other stakeholders in roles and participation.
7. Considers and respects personal differences, cultural beliefs, customs, as well as their effects to activity, role and participation.
8. Determines the need for research in occupational therapy practices and / or issues related to occupational therapy science, formulates relevant research questions, researches independently, and continues lifetime learning.
9. Carries out the responsibilities on the intervention by making it according to management and quality principles. Takes part in the quality improvement process of occupational therapy services and informs stakeholders.
10. Fulfills all roles required for professional performance, integrates all occupational therapy processes, and carries out its own practices with occupational therapy information. Plays an active role in the development, progression and introduction of occupational therapy.
