FIRST PART

Purpose, Scope, Basis, Definitions

Goal

ARTICLE 1 - The purpose of this regulation is; Bezmiâlem Vakif University Faculty of Medicine to determine the principles of education and measurement and evaluation.

Scope

ARTICLE 2 - (1) This Directive shall be applied to the regulation of the education and training programs implemented in the Faculty of Medicine according to the principles and decisions of the Higher Education Law and Higher Education Council; how to make measurements and evaluations; diplomas and titles; internship, finishing work and other teaching activities.

Base

ARTICLE 3 - (1) This directive is based on Bezmiâlem Vakif University Undergraduate and Undergraduate Education, Teaching and Examination Regulations.

Definitions

ARTICLE 4 - (1) In this regulation;

Academic Performance Monitoring Commission: Academic performance included; scientific publications, books, projects, patents, awards, lectures, tasks held in faculty education boards and commissions, follow-up of speeches made at scientific meetings,

the unit that enables the academic performance of the instructors to be reported to the higher committees in a more concrete way,

Accreditation and Self-Evaluation Board: The unit that undertakes the functions of preparation of the Self-Evaluation Report (ÖDR) for faculty accreditation, annual reporting for ÜTEAK in the following years, reporting and archiving of all educational and scientific activities, support for the accreditation processes of education branches,) Lesson: Starting from the beginning of the semester 4 to the semester of the semester 5

which will be completed and the lesson of the student about project execution,

Committee of Scientific Committee: It consists of 6 modules, which are under the supervision of mentors for the 4th and 5th semester students of the Faculty of Medicine; the unit which ensures that all processes from student science projects to presentation to publication are followed up,

Deanery: The Dean of the Faculty of Medicine,

Committee (Committee): In the first 3 years of the faculty, the group consisting of the lessons that are given in complementary features,

Chair of the course board:

instructed lecturer,

Lesson Year: The semester consists of two semesters,

Integrated System: The subjects are prepared and submitted together with the contribution of related science branches,

Developmental Examination (Formative Examination): During the course of a course, examinations conducted for evaluation purposes,

Clinical and Vocational Skills Commission: The unit that provides the basic skill training planning and implementation without faculty,

Pre-Graduation Coordination Board: Coordinator Board or Medical Education

In addition to the Commission, it also has the functions of the Curriculum Commission, which provides counseling services in the direction of the mission and vision of the Faculty, in the development of the pre-graduate medical education program,

(CEP) compliant educational program, following the educational process during the academic term and recommending to the relevant committees,

Postgraduate Education Commission: Provides training for students graduating from our faculty who follow the career development of the graduates of our faculty with the application of training processes aimed at national and international accreditation standards, updating assistant trails, standardization and improvement of working conditions, provision of rotation tracking and standardization, selection of assistant representatives and job descriptions unit of,

Objective Structured Clinical Examination (OSCE): Objective Structured Clinical Exams,

Common Compulsory Courses: Compulsory courses outside the course board,

SECOND PART

Admission, Registration and Status of Students First Admission and Registration Requirements

ARTICLE 5 - (1) Admission of students to the Faculty of Medicine affiliated to Bezmiâlem Vakif University is carried out according to the results of Selection and Placement Examinations organized by the Student Selection and Placement Center and other regulations determined by the Council of Higher Education. Candidate who has the right to become a student in the Faculty of Medicine To be able to register in person or through his / her representative within the period determined by the OSYM Presidency, the applicant must submit the documents specified in Article 13 of the Bezmiâlem Vakif University Undergraduate and Undergraduate Education and Training Regulations

Apply to the Bezmiâlem Vakif University Student Affairs Directorate.

Student Status

ARTICLE 6 - (1) In order for the student to be able to take advantage of his / her student rights and exemptions and to enter the exams, a condition must be provided that he / she has registered at the beginning of each year and has fulfilled the financial obligations prescribed by the Board of Trustees and determined by the Board of Trustees.

Transition from Other Universities

ARTICLE 7 - (1) From the Faculty of Medicine of Other Higher Education Institutions In the horizontal transitions to be made to the Faculty of Medicine of Bezmiâlem Vakif University, the provisions of the relevant regulation of the University of BEZMIALEM University and the Regulation Regarding the Transfer Principles of Associate and Undergraduate Degree between Higher Education Institutions are applied. the course adjustment of the student is done by the management board.

Students who transfer from the faculty to the Bezmiâlem Vakif University Faculty of Medicine

English Proficiency Exam is required. Those who fail the English proficiency test will be taught according to the provisions of "Bezmiâlem Vakif University Foreign Language Department Teaching and Examination Directive".

In order to enroll in the School of Medicine classes, applicants must be able to demonstrate that they are at a level where they can pursue English lessons in their departments. For this;

a. English by BEZMIALEM VAKIF University Foreign Language Department

Proficiency examination (CMS) 60,

b. Within the last two years from international exams which are accepted as equivalent by the Council of Higher Education;

75 in the TOEFL IBT (TOEFL Internet-Based Test), (at least 10 from each department)

CAE (Cambridge English Advanced) exam B,

Students who have taken the C in the Cambridge English Proficiency (CPE) exemption are exempted from the English Preparatory Program and begin their studies at the School of Medicine. Candidates who do not master English at the desired level continue to the English Preparatory Program to develop foreign languages.

Registration Renewal

ARTICLE 8 - (1) BEZMIALEM Vakıf University, Associate Degree and Undergraduate Education and Training Regulation shall be taken as basis.

Registration Suspension

ARTICLE 9 - (1) The records of the students, in the presence of the following reasons,

Board of Directors can be frozen by decision:

a) The health related excuse documented by the delegation report that the student will receive from health institutions,

b) Subdivision (2) of the first paragraph (d) of Article 7 of the Law no. 2547

learning in accordance with the third paragraph of this paragraph due to events that may lead to disruption of education and teaching. Interruption of the decision of the Council of Higher Education,

c) Due to natural disasters on condition that the area is documented with a document to be given in the highest administrative authority,

d) Documentation that the student will go abroad to learn a foreign language; but for this reason the registration is subject to the condition that the students who are registered for have to submit their passport records showing the dates of their entry and exit abroad to the relevant faculty.

e) According to the provisions of the Disciplinary Regulations of the Higher Education Institutions, the student must be convicted of not taking the punishment for removing from the higher education institution,

f) If the learner has lost or deferred his /

removal of a soldier by removal,

g) The detainee's detention,

h) The appearance of other cases which the Faculty Administrative Board will accept as valid and valid.

(2) Registration Suspension is made for an instruction year. One semester or less enrollment freezing can not be done. Students can register for up to one year at a time and up to two years during their studies.

(3) It is obligatory for the students to apply for registration freezing within a month at the latest from the date on which the reasons for the registration have to be frozen.

(4) In the case of freezing of registration, the student shall not process the maximum period of education prescribed in Article 44 of Law No. 2547.

(5) Students who exceed four semesters of absence within the entire duration of education due to mental disorders documented by the health report are required to take a health report from these students if they wish to continue their education. After this medical report is reviewed by the Faculty Administrative Board, it is decided whether the student can continue his education.

(6) Students who request freezing of registration must pay 25% of the tuition fee

It is difficult. Otherwise, the Registration Suspension request is not processed. The tuition fee paid for the registration freezing period will be deducted from the tuition fee at the beginning of the training.

a) If an academic year is frozen, the student must pay 50% of the tuition fee that he / she is obliged to pay for the academic year,

b) If the application is made after the last working day of the fourth week following the start of the courses, the student must pay the full tuition fee.

c) The courses taken from other higher education institutions during the period of freezing are not included in the students' programs in universities.

d) The student who freezes the registration is not refunded if he / she has paid for it for any reason.

(7) Students can not benefit from scholarships provided by the University during the period they are registering.

(8) When registration is frozen, the documents that the students gave to the University upon entry are not returned.

During the registration freezing period, the student can not participate in the education and training activities and exams, can not benefit from the student rights, and can not obtain the student certificate. The student continues education and teaching from where he left when his excuse is over.

Attachment and Separation

ARTICLE 10 - (1) Students shall be dismissed from the University with the decision of the Faculty and University Executive Boards in the following cases:

a) the request of the learner to delete the record at his / her own option,

b) The student has received a penalty for withdrawal from the higher education institution according to the provisions of the Student Disciplinary Regulations of Higher Education Institutions,

c) Documenting that the student can not continue his / her education or medical profession due to mental or physical illness

d) The student's transition to another higher education institution for any reason.

(2) Students who have been suspended due to the reasons stated above

If they apply to the Directorate with a petition, they will be given a document showing their status.

Documents that they give during enrollment to the university will be returned only after the transaction is made behind the high school diploma. A photocopy of the diploma is stored in the student's file.

(3) The teacher (1). intercepting the relationship with the university

In the case of concrete, Academic year for admitted students

the student has to pay 25% of the tuition fee which he / she is obliged to pay if he / she is done until the last working day of the fourth week following the start of the courses indicated in the calendar. In the event that the request for attachment is made after the last working day of the fourth week following the start of the lessons, the tuition fee which is obliged to pay must be paid by the student. The date on which petitions are entered into the official records of the university is taken as basis in the evaluation of the attachment requests.

THIRD PART

Education time

Education Year, Instructional Language and Yearbook

ARTICLE 11 - (1) The duration of the education at the Faculty of Medicine is 6 years, except for the preparatory class. Every year 2

Each semester lasts at least 14 weeks.

Instructional Language

ARTICLE 12 - (1) Bezmîâlem Vakıf University is taught at the Faculty of Medicine, in Turkish and English.

English preparatory class

ARTICLE 13 - (1) The candidates' English Proficiency

It is necessary to complete the exam. Those who fail the English proficiency test will be taught according to the provisions of "Bezmiâlem Vakif University Foreign Language Department Teaching and Examination Directive".

In order to enroll in the School of Medicine classes, applicants must be able to demonstrate that they are at a level where they can pursue English lessons in their departments. For this;

a. English by BEZMIALEM VAKIF University Foreign Language Department

Proficiency examination (CMS) 60,

b. Within the last two years from international exams which are accepted as equivalent by the Council of Higher Education;

75 in the TOEFL IBT (TOEFL Internet-Based Test), (at least 10 from each department)

CAE (Cambridge English Advanced) exam B,

Students who have taken the C in the Cambridge English Proficiency (CPE) exemption are exempted from the English Preparatory Program and begin their studies at the School of Medicine. Candidates who do not master English at the desired level continue to the English Preparatory Program to develop foreign languages.

Education Method

ARTICLE 14 - (1) Medical Education I., II. and III. the course committees consisting of years, IV, V. internship committees and VI. It is done according to the principle of internship per year.

In addition, I and II. over the years students have to choose at least one elective course each semester. If there are excessive imbalances in the number of students selected according to student preferences compared to other courses or classes, students may be placed in lower preferences. In these courses, the education is organized according to the semester basis. In case of attendance to elective courses, the provisions of the relevant article of this directive shall apply. In elective courses, general and make-up exams which are mentioned in the related article of this instruction are made, no midterm exam is made.

SECTION FOUR

Tasks

Class Coordinator and Tasks

ARTICLE 15 - (1) Responsible for all the course boards in the academic year

is the instructor.

a) Class Coordinators are assigned to the dean for 3 years.

b) prepare the academic calendar of the class for which he is responsible.

c) Ensure that the class of the class for which it is responsible is carried out in a uniform manner and in a uniform manner.

d) Examination of Course Board, internship exams, make-up exams and make-up exams in cooperation with the chairpersons of course and internship committee.

e) It allows calculation and explanation of exam results.

Internship Officers

ARTICLE 16- (1) The theoretical practice of the relevant internship shall be such that all kinds of course arrangements and examinations

Coordination support will be provided.

Chair and Duties of Course Committee

ARTICLE 17 - (1) The Chairman of the Course Committee is appointed by the Dean on the proposal of the Curriculum committee.

a) The course committee prepares the program, the program is complete and regular

.

b) The lecturers who teach in the course committee regularly and supervise their processing into the student attendance chart.

c) It is the responsibility of the first degree to collect questions about the examinations of the course committee and to print out the questionnaires, to ensure safety and order before, during and after the exam, and to calculate and explain the exam results correctly.

PART FIVE

Continue, Excuse and Permission

Continuation Obligation

ARTICLE 18 - (1) Practical (laboratory work, clinical studies, basic medical skills, etc.) and theoretical courses are obligatory. A student who does not attend more than 20% of the total of the relevant course hours, excused or excused separately for each practical course, is not taken to the course board and make-up exam and receives a "NA" grade. If absenteeism does not exceed 20%, the student has to compensate for the practical exercises that he / she does not attend, on the day and hour indicated by the instructor in the capacity of the Assistant Professor. Students who do not make remedial work do not take any exam for that course or course and get a "NA" grade.

(2) A student who does not attend more than 30% of the total of the relevant course hours separately for each theoretical course, excused or excused, is not taken to the course board and make-up exam and receives a "NA" grade.

Excuse Basis

ARTICLE 19 -

(1) Social, cultural, sports, etc., representing the university. the students who participate with the duties to be carried out by the Rectorate to all kinds of activities and organizations are considered to be excused from the courses and examinations on the days they are in charge.

(2) Those who have passed away from the first and second degree of relatives, with the date of their death and the date of the burial; documentation of social events, accidents, natural disasters and

those who have legitimate causes of Enforcement shall have the right to make excuses for interim exams.

(3) Students who want to be excused with health reasons,

With the petition explaining their excuse for the Faculty / Department Secretariat, the State and / or

They must submit a medical report issued by the Delegation from University Hospitals.

(4) Students who have been obstructing their entry into the labor Enforcement, must file a petition

Together, they must inform the Faculty Secretariat that they are affiliated within the latest (3) business days from the date of starting the excuse. Applications made under the scope of the Faculty Administrative Board are evaluated and accepted or rejected within the scope of this directive and legal regulations.

(5) Health reports cover all courses and exams on the day or days on which they belong. Reported students can not take the exams made on the dates they are reported. Students who take the exam and report after the exam are not excused for the exams they have entered. As reported, an investigation is launched on the students who entered the examination.

(6) The days in which the student is excused under this article are not counted from the time of absenteeism. Make-up exams are only for intermediate exams (Formative and Summative exams). Students who do not make excuses do not make excuses anymore. There is no make-up examination for the makeup exam.

(7) Regulations related to the above-mentioned continuation, courses of the Department of Science and Military Affairs, courses

committees, internships and semesters.

PART SIX

Score, Note, Rating and Coefficients

Points, Grades, and Coefficients

ARTICLE 20 - (1) The scores, grades and coefficients used in the evaluation of the Faculty of Medicine examinations are given below.

- a) A student who has taken one of the letter grades (AA), (BA), (BB), (CB) and (CC)
- b) If (F) is a letter grade, it means that dersten can not be successful. Students who take this note have to take this course again and this dersten must succeed.
- c) E: Exempted; those who are successful in the exemption examination, those who are in horizontal and vertical transitions, and those who have been taken while attending school in another higher education institution. E grades are not included in the average calculations.
- d) NA: Not Attended; students who can not fulfill attendance requirements. Evaluations are treated as F notes.

CHAPTER SEVEN

I., II. and III. Provisions for Classes

Examination Committee

ARTICLE 21 - (1) The course committee examinations are carried out during the semesters I, II, and III.

(2) A course committee examination may consist of more than one exam. The weight of these exams

is announced by the Dean's Office with the recommendation of the Measurement and Evaluation Committee at the beginning of the academic year. The course committee exams are all exams that are held during the course committees in Term I, II and III and which enable the calculation of a single achievement score for each course committee. Examinations are held on the dates specified in the academic calendar, at the place and time declared by the dean.

Lecture Note

ARTICLE 22 - (1). Developmental Examinations (Formative) made during the course of each course and Examination of the course committee at the end of the course committee; is the weighted sum of the scores obtained from the final written exam (summative) and the objective structured clinical exam (OSCE). The content and components of all exams are determined by the medical education commission at the beginning of each academic year, and are linked to the Faculty of Medicine. Formal examinations are not conducted for courses that last less than four (4) weeks. The dam system is applied in calculating the course board grade. Damage is not applied in the Developmental Examinations (Formative). In the last written exams (Summative), the questions of the sections with the number of questions less than five (5) are collected and the dam is applied as a whole.

Calculation of Course Board Note

ARTICLE 23 - (1) The success point of the course committee is 60. Course Board Success Note, Development

(Formative) and Probing Based Learning (PBL), Case Based Assessment (OTD) (if done) and final written (Summative) exams at the end of the course. The notes of practical (practical) courses are added to the summative examinations.

The ratio of the exams to the achievement grade and contents of the medical education at the beginning of each academic year

is recommended by the commission and decided at the faculty committee.

(2) In order to be successful in elective courses; student, elective

must take at least 60% of the full grade in the make-up exam.

(3) In joint compulsory courses; 40% of the midterm grade with general / makeup exam

Notation corresponding to the number given by the sum of 60%. In joint compulsory courses, at least 50 conditions are required for general and complementary examination.

Board Committee Success

ARTICLE 24 - (1) The student who has got at least 60 points from the course committee is deemed successful from that establishment.

Makeup Exams

ARTICLE 25 - (1) Regarding the make-up exams:

a) The course committee make-up exam is for students who fail from any course board. There is a makeup examination for each course board once. Completion exams of the course committees completed in the fall semester are completed before the second semester begins, and completion examinations of the course committees completed in the spring semester are held on the dates specified after the school closes.

b) Make-up exams are held at the place and time announced by the dean's office on the date specified in the academic calendar.

Elective and Common core exams

ARTICLE 26 - Vocational English, elective and joint compulsory courses are made once at the place and time announced by the deanery after the completion of the courses.

Passing the Class

Article 27 - (1) Class passing rules are as follows:

a) Even if the subclasses are committees that fail, the student must

may continue in accordance with the defined conditions.

b) Students from any one of the Spiral 1 and Spiral 2 course boards must be successful from all courses up to the beginning of Spiral 4. The student who can not succeed in the course passes can not start the 4th spiral (4th Grade).

c) The course committees in Spiral 3 form the precursors of the traineeships in Spiral 4. These premises are annually announced and announced by the faculty board at least one month before the start of the education period. Student who can not succeed in the announced predecessors (pre-conditional courses) can not take the internship committee that is ahead of that forecaster in spiral 4. They may attend non-premise internship groups.

d) It is obligatory to complete internships by year.

e) In semester 1 and 2, to be able to continue a higher level, 50% of the total ECTS of the year except for the common compulsory and elective courses must be completed.

f) If the attendants of the upper classes are not absent from the course, they will take the examination of the board and the make-up examination of the course board, and those who are absent from the course will be entitled to the exam after continuing to the related course board.

g) 5. Beginning of the course, the first 3 walks are required to be successful from all courses.

SECTION EIGHT

IV. and V. Classes

Completion of Internships

ARTICLE 28 - (1) Continuity in the internship is essential. However, if the student declares any of the excuses mentioned in Article 19, if the absenteeism is not exceeded 20%, the Chairman of the Undersecretary of the Ministry of Education may compensate for the duration of absenteeism and count the duration of this compensation. If the time to compensate for absenteeism is exceeded, or if there is no time to make up for it, the student makes an internship. Compensation can be provided on weekends or overtime work.

Students who do not complete all remedies will not be able to take the exam.

Internship Exams and Passing Note

ARTICLE 29 - (1) Internship Exams; (formative) during the internship, the final written exam (summative) at the end of the internship and the objective structured clinical exam (OSCE) examinations

It occurs.

(2) Internship Board Success Note; The internship course consists of the achievement grade and the sum of the achievement grade of the science course. Internship grades exceed 95% of success grades and 5% of science subjects

notes. The internship grade achievement grade is the sum of the formal exams (if done) and the summative exams. The criteria for calculating the content rating and criteria of these exams as well as the contribution of the scientific board to the passing grade are determined by the faculty board in each academic year. In order to pass the internship successfully, the internship committee must score 60 points on the notation weighted from the science achievement grade.

Internship Make-up Examination and Repetition of Internships

ARTICLE 30 - (1) IV. and V. Classes may be taken once for exams made for other internship groups at the year of the student who failed one or more of the internships or at the end of the year for the internship exam. Students who fail the internship exam make an internship

It is difficult. Makeup exams are held at the place and time announced by the deanery at the times specified in the academic calendar.

Internship Notation Calculator

ARTICLE 31 - (1) IV. and V. to determine the grades of successful students,

averages of notes 25. The academic achievement grade averages of the students are calculated by the Student Affairs Directorate at the end of the year.

During this calculation, the student has two averages, namely the academic achievement grade point average (GPA) and the general academic grade average (GPA).

(2) The academic grade average for the year is calculated taking into consideration the weight of each internship.

Scientific Course Review

ARTICLE 32 - (1) The course of science consists of 6 modules in total. During the internship period, there are goals to be completed by the student in each module. The rules to be followed in pursuing the objectives and the scientific committee are determined by the relevant commissions and presented to the faculty board. The science lesson, I and II, is included in the 4th and 5th grade lesson plans, and the student is considered "successful" or "unsuccessful" by considering one and a half year's work,

There is no prerequisite between the two courses. The student can not go to the internship if the lessons they have won do not finish until the 5th grade. A student who does not submit the prepared reports and does not close the project is considered as unsuccessful in the science lesson.

NINTH PART

VI. Class (Family Medicine-Internship) Provisions

VI. Evaluation of Class Internships

ARTICLE 33 - (1) In order to be able to start the sixth grade, it is essential to be successful in all the courses in this lesson which are included in the lesson plan.

(2) The success of the students in the sixth grade (internship), the successes in the seminars and similar activities in each of the fields are evaluated by the department.

diplomas

ARTICLE 34 - (1) The following diplomas are granted at the Faculty of Medicine.

a) Basic Medical Sciences Associate Degree Diploma: Those who can not complete medical education or who can not complete medical education are required to obtain a two-year upper secondary education.

b) Medical Doctor Diploma: Except for the prescribed preparatory class for the Medical Doctor, each

Those who have successfully completed a six-year training period covering a course year are awarded the "Medical Doctorate Diploma".

SECTION TEN

Miscellaneous Provisions

Objection to Exam Results

ARTICLE 35 - (1) The students shall make their objections to the Dean within the latest 7 days after the results are announced. These objections are subject to review by the chairperson of the relevant course committee and relevant faculty members. If any material error is found by the Measurement and Evaluation Commission, the necessary corrections are made with the approval of the relevant committees. If the question is canceled, scoring is done by recalculating the remaining questions.

Excuse Exam

ARTICLE 36 - (1) An excuse examination is opened when the excuse of a student who can not enter any Course Board or internship exam is accepted. The make-up exam takes place on the date, place and time specified by the dean's office.

(2) There is no make-up exam for the course committee exams and internship exams.

Removed Directive and Transitional Provision

ARTICLE 37- (1) This Directive shall replace the Directive dated 24.08.2016. It the students who enrolled before the entry into Enforcement of the directive also provisions.

Enforcement

ARTICLE 38 - (1) This Directive shall enter into Enforcement on 20/09/2017, when it is accepted by the BEZMIALEM VAKIF University Senate.

Executive

ARTICLE 39 - (1) The provisions of this directive shall be executed by the Faculty of Medicine of BEZMIALEM Vakif University.
