Information About the Nutrition and Dietetics Department

General Information:

The Department of Nutrition and Dietetics has the capacity to provide information, skills and sensitivity to analyze and solve social problems in nutrition, nutrition counseling and education in hospitals and other health institutions, nutrition industry, production, management and organization, research and development, nutrition plan and to train qualified dietitians in areas such as the creation and implementation of their programs.

The Department of Nutrition and Dietetics degree program consists of four years of education and training. The first stage of vocational education and training program includes basic sciences, medicine and nutrition sciences, which are essential for dietetic applications. The second stage is directly related to the field of application. In addition to theoretical teaching and laboratory practices, the student is engaged in community health and nutrition summer internships and other internships in hospitals and other institutions with regard to therapeutic and collective nutrition management. With this program application, the student acquires and develops the principles, concepts, knowledge and skills necessary for the dietician profession.

Grade Level Gained:

This program is a graduate-level program.

Requirements and Rules of Gain

Nutrition and Dietetics To obtain a Bachelors Degree Diploma, the principles set forth in the Regulations of Associate Degree and Undergraduate Education and Training of Bezmialem Foundation University must be followed.

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- (1) Diplomas are awarded to students who successfully complete the education and training in the program. The matters to be included in diplomas are determined by the decision of the Senate.
- (2) At the diplomas given at the end of the undergraduate education and training, the dean or the director of the college and the diploma at the end of the associate degree and associate degree education are signed by the vocational school director and the rector.
- (3) A certificate of honor and honor will be given to the students who receive the diploma together with a certificate showing this status.

Registration Admission Requirements:

In order to be eligible for this program, it is necessary to have completed a high school or equivalent education and have received sufficient points in the National License Placement Examination (LYS). The students will be admitted according to the principles determined by the Higher Education Council and the programa MF-3 score. Foreign students are accepted within the success criteria set by the Senate.

Recognition of Prior Learning:

Students may apply for exemption from courses they have taken and attained from an institution of higher education that they have previously enrolled in, or from an accredited institution. The exemption requests are connected to the board of directors by taking the opinion of the lecturer who gives the related course when necessary.

Examination, Assessment and Grading:

Bezmiâlem The principles stated in the Vocational College Associate Degree and Undergraduate Education and Training Regulations shall apply.

The success of a course is determined by the course grade. The course grade is obtained by evaluating the student's achievement in the semester and the general examination together with the midterm exams and midterm exams, applied studies, group work and similar studies. In order for a course to be successful, the course grade must be at least 60 out of 100 points and the final or complementary exam grade must be at least 50.

Instructional Form:

Full-time undergraduate teaching.

Graduation Requirements:

Bezmiâlem Vakıf University is deemed to have completed the student's education and fulfilled the requirements for graduation to fulfill the principles stated in the Associate Degree and Undergraduate Education and Training Regulations. Students who have successfully completed all the courses, practices and internships that are envisaged in the program and who have received a total of at least 240 ECTS credits are entitled to a diploma. The students who are entitled to graduation are given a diploma of the relevant program according to the provisions of the relevant regulations.

Occupational Profiles of Occupations-Employment Opportunities:

In addition to serving as a researcher, educator and therapist in maternity bed treatment institutions, children and elderly nursing homes, maternal and child health, community health and special diet policlinics, they can also work as an administrator and academician in other public institutions. Also graduates; They can also work as a manager, researcher and educator in private or public institutions related to nutrition and nutrition in other public institutions. This program is assigned as a dietician to the mentioned public areas in case graduates are required to get the required score of KPSS (Public Personnel Selection Examination).

Transition to a Top Grade:

The rules may be applied to proficiency programs in arts with master's and doctoral programs determined by YÖK (Higher Education Committee) and related higher education institution.
